**Be smart on the internet**

**S SAFE** Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information – such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name – to people you are chatting with online.

**M MEETING** Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.

**A ACCEPTING** Accepting emails, text messages, or opening files, pictures or links from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems – they may contain viruses or nasty messages!

**R RELIABLE** Information you find on the Internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are.

**T TELL** Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online. You can report online abuse to the police at [www.thinkuknow.co.uk](http://www.thinkuknow.co.uk).

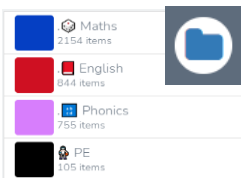

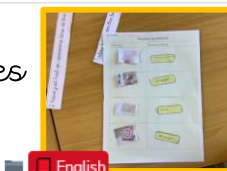


# Using my iPad in School:

Use the folders in Seesaw to organise my learning journal by subject area.



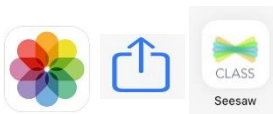
Upload and of practical activities I complete (e.g. those not in my book).



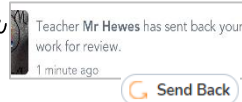
Use the to record over my work and explain my learning verbally, using the sentence stems provided by my teacher.



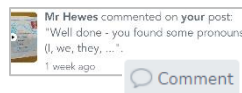
Screenshot or Screen Record any learning I do on my iPad (outside of Seesaw) and upload this to my journal.



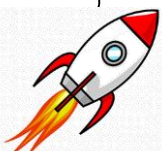
Check your daily to look for any work to edit and resubmit to your teacher.
